It is my pleasure to inform you the State has set aside \$50,000 in FY2005 Land and Water Conservation Fund monies to assist the City of Gardiner with the Downtown Waterfront Project. The project has received State approval and must now be submitted to the National Park Service (NPS) for review and final approval.

Prior to submitting your project to National Park Service for final approval, I would like to meet with you to review your project cost and match figures. Please contact me so that we can set up a date and time to meet.

You are reminded that the City should not make any expenditures on the project prior to execution of a State-Local LWCF Project Agreement (PA), which will be sent to you following federal approval. Once the PA is in place, all project contracts for engineering, materials purchase, or construction must be submitted to this office for review and approval, so please allow as least seven (7) days for our review before advertising for bids on any work. Further instructions regarding bidding, record keeping, and billing will be sent along with the PA.
