The Department is interested in local concerns and issues related to the project, and how the project relates to any local comprehensive plans. Specific issues to be discussed include future roadway widths, bridge replacement/rehabilitation options, roadway alignments, maintenance of traffic during construction, right of way concerns and utility concerns. Anyone with an interest in the project is invited to attend and participate in the meeting.
