A Resolution Proclaiming the Week of September 17, 2006 through September 23, 2006 as Constitution Week.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF GARDINER, MAINE:

WHEREAS, September 17, 2006 marks the two hundred and seventeenth anniversary of the adoption on the Constitution of the United States of America by the Constitutional Convention; and

WHEREAS, To accord official recognition to this memorable anniversary, and to The patriotic exercise that will form a noteworthy feature of the occasion, it seems fitting and proper; and

WHEREAS, Public Law No. 915 guarantees the issuing of a proclamation each year by the President of the United States of America designating September 17 through September 23 as Constitution Week;

NOW, Therefore, Be It Resolved by the Mayor and City Council that the week of September 17, 2006 through September 23, 2006 shall be designated as Constitution Week in the City of Gardiner and all citizens are urged to pay special attention during the week to the Constitution and the advantages of American citizenship.
