Dear Mr. Kobrock:

As you may be aware, Time Warner Inc. has recently announced plans to fully divest itself of its interest in Time Warner Cable Inc. The ultimate result of Time Warner Inc.'s divestiture of its interest in Time Warner Cable Inc. (the "Spin-Off") will be that Time Warner Cable Inc. will become entirely owned by public shareholders.

As a result of this transaction, there will be no transfer of the franchise and no change in local management or staff as a result of the Spin-off. In the next few days, you will be receiving a packet of information that will explain the Spin-Off in more detail. Following receipt of this information, you may choose to take no action or, if you wish to formally approve the Spin-Off, you may do so by placing the attached resolution on your council agenda for approval.

Following the Spin-Off, Time Warner Cable will continue to provide your residents, our customers, the excellent care and services we have always provided. Since acquiring the Adelpia systems in August 2006, Time Warner Cable has launched high speed data and digital phone service in over ninety percent of those acquired systems. In addition, upgrades are currently underway in the former Pine Tree systems which Time Warner Cable acquired in November, 2007. We are proud of our commitment to Maine and trust you will work with us to make the Spin-Off a seamless transaction for Time Warner Cable.
