You are reminded that the Town should not make any expenditures on the project prior to execution of a State-Local LWCF Project Agreement (PA), which will be sent to you following federal approval. Once the PA is in place, all project contracts for engineering, materials purchase, or construction must be submitted to this office for review and approval, so please allow as least seven (7) days for our review before advertising for bids on any work. Further instructions regarding bidding, record keeping, and billing will be sent along with the PA.
