"Walk for the Trail" will be held **Saturday, June 27th starting at the Maine State Housing Authority Parking Lot located on Water Street in Augusta.** Registration forms are available on the KRRT website or at various locations in the local area. Pre-registration deadline is Monday June 22nd. Check-in and onsite registration will begin one hour before your event begins.

30 Mile Challenge will start at 5:30 am
Half- Marathoners will start at 7:30 a.m. (registration begins at 6:30 a.m. at Old Fort Western)
Walk for the Trail participants will start at 9:30 a.m. (registration begins at 8:30 a.m.)
Refreshments, prizes, and drawings will be offered during the closing ceremony beginning at 11:30 a.m. at the FKRRT booth in the Capital Park.
All events will take place rain or shine

Collect Pledges

Please don't stop with your registration fee. Use this sponsor form to get support from your family, friends, and co-workers. All participants will receive a goodie bag. Trail-a-thon Routes

- ⊛ Capital Connector - 2.0 mile walk starts at the MSHA parking lot, goes along the Kennebec River Rail Trail (KRRT), up the Capital Connector to the YMCA parking lot, then back to the MSHA parking lot.
 - ⊛ Augusta-Hallowell: - 4.0 mile walk starts at the MSHA parking lot, follows the Kennebec River Rail Trail to the Hallowell municipal parking lot, then turns back on KRRT and returns to the MSHA parking lot.
 - ⊛ Augusta-Gardiner - 13.0 mile walk starts at the MSHA parking lot, goes along the KRRT to the Hannaford Parking lot in Gardiner and returns to the MSHA parking lot.
 - ⊛ The 30 Mile Challenge: - 30 mile route starts at the MSHA parking lot and is created by the participant.
- If you can't finish or run into difficulty, please speak to one of our workers in a KRRT Volunteer T-shirt.**

Other Considerations

- ⊛ There will be plenty of parking on Water Street and the parking lots in Downtown Augusta.
- ⊛ Please keep dogs on leashes and use the dog-i-pot bags to keep our trail clean.
- ⊛ All participants please be mindful of the other walkers and runners
- ⊛ The trail is wheel chair accessible.
