Re: Use of the Gardiner Sportsman's Club 2005

Historically the recreation program has used the Sportsman's Club for swimming and summer programs. Last year the members graciously allowed us to use the inside of the building as well as the ground for eight weeks 6:30 am – 5:30 pm. In return we paid their utilities for 3 months, mowed the lawns, put in the docks and cleaned all areas we used.

Attendance in this school age summer camp program was over 100 children, grades 2-5. With attendance this high we need to have the program in one location in order to keep costs at a level parents can afford to pay.

I met with the members of the Sportsman's Club on January 27th to work out the details for this summer 2005. At this time the members present let me know that they had voted to have the program go back to the hours we had in the past, Monday through Thursday 9:00 am – 3:00 pm and limited use of the building.

After discussions with staff regarding moving 100+ children from site to site twice a day and having to deal with outside groups also using the Sportsman's Club, we determined that it would be best for the program to make other plans for summer camp 2005.

I have sent a letter to the Gardiner Sportsman's Club letting them know we would not be requesting use of their facility for summer programs. I also thanked them for their support in the past.
