Jeff,

Finally got a hold of David Allen on 2-23-05 from MDOT here is what he had to say.

Mr. Allen advised that he received approximately 6 phone calls from Ms. Sirois along with some written correspondence, as it pertains to her complaints against Anthony Automotive. Mr. Allen went on to state that her primary complaints were Anthony Automotive utilizing MDOT right of way to conduct his business as well as the issue of no parking on route 201.

Issue # 1 Right-of Way

Mr. Allen advised us that they sent a ROW specialist to Anthony Automotive and asked them to move their inventory etc. back from the right -of-way.

Issue # 2 No Parking on 201

Mr Allen advised Ms. Sirois as to the no parking complaint. MDOT would support the City's decision to make that part of 201 no parking and provide the signage but that MDOT did not see any compelling reason to come in and do it themselves, that it was purely a local decision.

Mr. Allen informed us that he advised Ms. Sirois at that time (after the last call) that any future complaints or concerns that she may have should be sent to MDOT's legal department, and not to contact him directly. Mr Allen informed us this action was a result of her unhappiness as to what MDOT was telling her at that time.

Mr. Allen also informed us that he conducted his own speed zone study and found no compelling reason for any action to take place at this time.
