Background Information

In January the city submitted a Letter of Intent for the 2020 Community Enterprise Program in the amount of \$100,000. This grant has a 25% match, however the match will come from the businesses receiving the facade grant. After the Office of Community Development reviewed the Letter of Intent the city received notification for approval to submit a full application. This grant submission is by invitation only and has a deadline of April 10, 2020.

As part of the grant application process, the city must hold a public hearing to discuss the application and any comments Council and/or the public may have (completed under item 3.b).
