Background Information

The City of Gardiner was approached by MSAD #11 to possibly donate up to three loads of gravel. (See attached email.)

The City Manger reached out to Michael Stolz, MMA Attorney regarding this request. He informed the city that such a donation decision should be a matter of legislative determination action (City Council acting as the legislative body would need to decide if public resources could be provided at the taxpayers expense).

He suggested that the school district be told that this project affects all of the municipalities that have students in the district and all should have an opportunity to be involved (asked to donate gravel also).

Of course, the City Council can make a decision to not ask the other municipalities and make the small donation themselves.
