

Please accept my regrets as I inform you that I will need to step down from my at large council seat here in Gardiner beginning Friday, July 30, 2021. My husband and I have decided to sell our home on Highland Avenue to begin the fulfillment of our long- term plan to retire in Nova Scotia to be near our only child and his future family. Our home is currently under contract and we are due to vacate the premises on July 30. Due to a tight rental market, our next residence will be in Augusta rather than here in Gardiner.
