### **CAMPAIGN**

**BGCKV Clubhouse has served** the community well for over 60 years. First, as the Pray Street School opening in 1956 and now as the home of the Boys & Girls Clubs of Kennebec Valley. We also serve the community as a place for youth sports and programs. Given the age of the building, extensive maintenance required and current state guidelines, the building has reached the end of its useful life. Renovation of the building was far costlier than building new.

Construction will be significantly more cost-efficient and creates an opportunity to expand our membership to meet the growing need. Annually we serve more than 3,000 youth, with more than 1,800 enrolled as members at the Club and another 1,700 youth served through community outreach.


