A Resolution Honoring A1 Diner and Owners Mike Giberson and Neil Anderson

WHEREAS, the A1 Diner (Worcester Diners #790) was installed in 1946 at 3 Bridge Street, Gardiner, as Heald's Bridge Street Lunch; and

WHEREAS, Mike Giberson and Neil Anderson purchased the Diner in 1988 from Mike's father Albert, thereby owning and operating the Diner longer than any previous proprietors; and

WHEREAS, Mike Giberson and Neil Anderson have always valued local, quality ingredients, and excellent customer service at the A1 Diner; and

WHEREAS, Mike Giberson and Neil Anderson offered an eclectic menu of diner food and innovative Maine cuisine to appeal to local patrons and the millions of visitors crossing the Kennebec, each way, in search of a unique dining experience; and

WHEREAS, the A1 Diner was one of the first restaurants in Maine to be smoke-free in 1990; and

WHEREAS, the A1 Diner has been featured in several nationwide magazines, such as New York Times, Down East, and Yankee; and

WHEREAS, Mike Giberson and Neil Anderson used creativity to encourage each trainee to develop his or her own skills and talents; and

WHEREAS, Mike Giberson and Neil Anderson actively participated in the vision, establishment, and development of Gardiner Main Street, as well as investing in their community by opening A1 to Go in 2002; and

WHEREAS, Mike Giberson received the Maine Downtown Center award for Volunteer of the Year in 2005, served as President of Gardiner Main Street Board of Directors, and as a member of the Gardiner City Council; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and City Council of the City of Gardiner hereby joins the citizens of Gardiner and City Staff in expressing their sincere appreciation to the **A1 Diner** and Owners Mike Giberson and Neil Anderson for all the many positive contributions to our community.
