## A Resolution Honoring Thomas Harnett

WHEREAS, Thomas Harnett has served for six-years as Mayor within the City of Gardiner, and had also completed one full term as City Councilor for the City; and

**WHEREAS**, during his tenure on City Council **Thomas Harnett** served the City of Gardiner and its citizens in a variety of capacities, including being a member of the Recreation Committee, the Fire Committee, Ex-officio Board Member of Gardiner Main Street; and

- A steadfast commitment to equal rights for all people
