Dear Gardiner City Council,

Thank you for considering Gardiner Main Street's major special event application to hold Swine and Stein Brewfest In downtown Gardiner on Saturday, October 8, 2022. Each year we work closely with the City's public works, police and fire departments to ensure it is a safe and well-run event. The event draws 1,200+ people from across our region and beyond, with several attendees coming from the Boston area. It's an excellent opportunity to showcase our downtown to new visitors who will hopefully return at other times in the year.

Our beer festival format, which we introduced in 2019, will host 20-25 Maine craft alcoholic beverage producers as vendors on the street as their representatives serve sample-sized servings to event attendees. These vendors will all be licensed by the State of Maine and have a greater knowledge of safe serving practices than our typical volunteer. Gardiner Main Street obtains a Special Taste Testing Event license from the Maine Bureau of Alcoholic Beverages and Lottery Operations. Since 2009, we have worked closely with the Gardiner Police Department to ensure that there are no problems with overconsumption or other issues that can occur with alcohol-based events. We will continue to offer a special rate for designated drivers which includes complimentary non-alcoholic beverages all day. The event is also smoke and vape free.

Gardiner Main Street appreciates working with all city staff and council around this event. To address concerns from downtown businesses, we will keep sidewalks open to the public with multiple exit and re-entry points along the event area in the street. To reduce crowded areas, we are looking into options to extend the footprint of the event area on the street. With public 220 amp power access only available in the middle of the block at Dearborn Park, we are looking into other sources of power to allow for more flexibility on stage placement. If an alternative power solution becomes available, we would like to flip the traditional event layout, placing the stage close to the post office and extending the event area further down the block towards Church Street. This option was not finalized at the time of submitting the major event permit, but will be decided no later than 3 weeks prior to the event. Please see attached event map for more details on the traditional event layout and the possible variation. Any event layout changes will be coordinated with the City's Public Works and Public Safety departments, and also communicated with downtown businesses and residents.

Swine & Stein is Gardiner Main Street's largest annual fundraiser. We would appreciate council's consideration once again for a partial waiver for police department overtime costs and a full waiver for public works labor costs associated with the event. Thank you for reviewing the event permit and I would be happy to answer any questions you may have regarding Swine and Stein Brewfest at your upcoming meeting.


