We do acknowledge the odors associated with our product and we are committed to comply with all regulations as well as be a good neighbor to those living and working near our business.

Frazer Milton is currently the head grower at a similar sized medical marijuana cultivation facility in Portland. They have a proven Odor Mitigation Plan that we will duplicate at 8 ABJ Drive, Unit 2.

We use large carbon filters attached to inline fans in all of our flower, drying and trimming/packaging rooms that run continuously while there is any growing/drying/processing occurring in any particular room. Our standard is the CanFilter 150 fan with a carbon filter and a pre filter. In addition, we have two extra carbon filters in the building that also run continuously, one in the front lobby and one in the office.

We have a carbon filter for every room, but not all of our rooms are utilized at all times, so at harvest (which is the most odiferous time), we take a minimum of two carbon filters from unused rooms and place them in the hallway that runs down the center of the building.

Unfortunately, high quality carbon filters do not have a well defined effective life and they last on average 12-18 months. The carbon filter elements must be changed whenever a slight odor is detected within the building. Last, but not least, we will ask our immediate neighbors at 8 ABJ Drive to notify us immediately if they ever detect any smell that may be originating from our business. There is a supply store in Augusta that is approximately 8 miles away that stocks these filters so we can acquire and install replacement carbon filter elements immediately when necessary.
